On July 7, 2016, The Walt Disney Company (the Company) entered into a Terms Agreement with Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Incorporated and Morgan Stanley & Co. LLC, as representatives of the underwriters named therein, with respect to the offer and sale of \$500,000,000 aggregate principal amount of its 0.875% Notes Due 2019 (the 2019 Notes), \$1,000,000,000 aggregate principal amount of its 1.850% Notes Due 2026 (the 2026 Notes) and \$500,000,000 aggregate principal amount of its 3.000% Notes Due 2046 (the 2046 Notes and, together with the 2019 Notes and the 2026 Notes, the Notes). The 2019 Notes were offered to the public at 99.664% of par and proceeds to the Company with respect to the 2019 Notes net of underwriting discounts and commissions of 0.200%, before expenses, was 99.464% of par. The 2026 Notes were offered to the public at 97.897% of par and proceeds to the Company with respect to the 2016 Notes net of underwriting discounts and commissions of 0.200%, before expenses, was 99.464% of par and proceeds to the Company with respect to the 2016 Notes net of underwriting discounts and commissions of 0.750%, before expenses, was 95.462% of par. The 2046 Notes net of underwriting discounts and commissions of 0.750%, before expenses, was 95.462% of par. The Notes were registered under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, pursuant to the shelf registration statement on Form S-3 (File No. 333-192690) of the Company. The Notes are being issued pursuant to a Senior Debt Securities Indenture, dated as of September 24, 2001, between the Company and Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, as trustee.
