On June 19, 2009, the Issuer cancelled, pursuant to the Issuer's option exchange program, an option granted to the Reporting Person on  
(5) August 15, 2008. Each exchanged option to purchase one share of common stock was replaced with a new option to purchase a number of shares of common stock equal to the number of options exchanged multiplied by 0.83 which represents an exchange ratio based on the exercise price of the exchanged option, subject to rounding.
- (6) The original shares underlying this option vest in forty-eight equal monthly installments beginning on April 3, 2010.
