Item 1.01 Entry into a Definitive Material Agreement

On November 21, 2014, Tanger Factory Outlet Centers, Inc. (the "Company"), announced that its operating partnership, Tanger Properties Limited Partnership (the "Operating Partnership"), completed a public offering of the Operating Partnership's \$250 million in aggregate principal amount 3.750% Senior Notes due 2024 (the "Notes"), pursuant to an underwriting agreement (the "Underwriting Agreement") with Jefferies LLC, Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Incorporated, SunTrust Robinson Humphrey, Inc., U.S. Bancorp Investments, Inc. and Wells Fargo Securities, LLC as joint book-running managers. The Notes were offered and sold under a prospectus supplement and related prospectus filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission pursuant to a shelf registration statement on Form S-3. The Underwriting Agreement has been previously filed on Form 8-K on November 14, 2014.

The Notes are governed by the Indenture, dated as of March 1, 1996, among the Operating Partnership, the Company, and U.S. Bank National Association (as successor in interest to Street Bank and Trust Company), as supplemented by the Fourth Supplemental Indenture, dated as of November 5, 2005, the Fifth Supplemental Indenture, dated as of August 16, 2006, the Sixth Supplemental Indenture, dated as of July 2, 2009, the Seventh Supplemental Indenture, dated as of June 7, 2010, the Eight Supplemental Indenture, dated as of November 25, 2013, and the Ninth Supplemental Indenture, dated as of November 21, 2014, further amended or supplemented from time to time. A copy of the Ninth Supplemental Indenture is attached hereto as Exhibit 4.1 and is incorporated by reference herein.
