On February 19, 2008, Thomas W. Adams, chairman and chief executive officer and Robert C. On January 16, 2008, the Company's wholly owned subsidiary, Tronox LLC, received an information request, pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (42 U.S.C. §§ 9601, et seq.), through which the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region II, is seeking additional information related to the transactions that resulted in the ultimate spin off of the Company and its subsidiaries from Kerr-McGee Corporation. A similar information request was served on Anadarko Petroleum Corporation on or about the same date.
